## Product Description

**NOPE!® ID+ Wasp and Hornet Killer** is an amateur use aerosol insecticide for use against wasps and hornets nests indoors and outdoors plus use against moths and flies. To avoid risks to human or animal health, or the environment, comply with the instructions for use.

<b>Active Ingredient(s)</b>	Permethrin (0.25 %w/w) Tetramethrin (0.24 %w/w)
<b>Storage</b>	Keep the container tightly closed. Store in a cool, dry, well ventilated place. Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuffs. The floor must be impermeable and form a collecting basin so that, in the event of an accidental spillage, the liquid cannot spread beyond this area. Store locked up in the original sealed container. Do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50°C/122°F

## Application Information

### Preparation

Read the label before treatment. Shake before use. Before application, ensure that all people, animals, pets (including terrariums and aquariums) and food stuffs are removed from the area to be treated.

If planning to treat a nest, look for entrance/s by observing the flight paths of workers in the early morning or evening to locate a steady stream of wasps entering a specific spot.

### Application

Aiming at singular insects, spray product in 1 – 2 second bursts directly at wasps and hornets for full control.

Aiming at the nest entrance, spray the product until empty from a distance up to 5 m away, don't stand directly underneath the nest while applying and take note of the direction of the wind so the spray is not blown back into your face. Wasps are social creatures so take care when dealing with a nest as distressed wasps release a pheromone that sends the nearby colony into a defensive, stinging frenzy.

**NEVER** treat a wasps nest yourself if you think you might be allergic to stings, you could be sent into **ANAPHYLAXIS**, this is a life-threatening allergic reaction. **CALL 999 IF YOU THINK YOU OR SOMEONE ELSE IS HAVING AN ANAPHYLACTIC REACTION.**

The best time to deal with a nest is early in the morning or late in the evening when activity is lower. Nests will be smaller and easier to treat during the spring when there are fewer insects.

After treating the nest, leave the area for at least 24 hours and keep children/animals away during treatment.

DO NOT remove wasps nests until you are sure there is no activity left, wasps abandon their nests after the summer and will not return to it the following year so the safest time to remove the nests is during the winter, wear gloves and protective clothing if the nest has been treated with an insecticide such as the **NOPE!® ID+ Wasp and Hornet Killer**.

If after using the **NOPE!® ID+ Wasp and Hornet Killer** there is still activity around the nest, consideration should be given to contacting a professional pest control service.

## Other Information

Precautions: This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. Keep in a safe place. Wash hands and exposed skin before meals and after use. Action should be taken to prevent foraging bees gaining access to treated nests, preferably by removing the combs or blocking the nest entrance. All bats are protected under the wildlife and countryside act 1981, before treating any structure used by bats, consult Natural England, Scottish, Natural Heritage or the Countryside Council for Wales. Cover all water storage tanks before application. **HAZARDOUS TO BEES.** Do not contaminate foodstuffs, eating utensils or food contact surfaces. Do not apply directly to animals. Do not apply to clothing or human bedding. Not to be used on pet bedding, pet sleeping quarters or where pets frequently/ normally lie. Do not touch treated surfaces until dry. This biocidal product contains Permethrin, which can cause severe adverse reactions in cats. Do not use on cats, or items intended to be used by cats. Keep cats away during treatment and drying time. Exclude animals during application.
