What You Will Need:



Bottle 1, Mould Eliminator

Eliminates mould.

Bottle 2, Mould Sanitiser

Sanitises surfaces.





Gloves

Protects hands.

Cloth

Dries wet surfaces.



You can find all of these in the box.

Step 1: Safety First





Put on the Gloves.

Open a window.

Keep any children and pets away.

Step 2: Prepare The Area



Remove nearby clutter, plants or soft furnishings.

Brush dirt away from the area.

Step 3: Spray To Eliminate





Spray the mould with **Bottle 1**, **Mould Eliminator.**

Do not spray near your face.

Wait 3 minutes.

Step 4: Wipe To Dry





When the mould stain has gone, wipe it dry with the Cloth.

Step 5: Spray To Prevent





Spray the area with Bottle 2, Mould Sanitiser.

Wait 1 hour.

Step 6: Complete!





The surface is now properly treated and mould-free.



Repeat treatment every 6 months, or if you spot mould.



Stop Mould Coming Back:



Air Rooms Daily

Open windows for a few minutes each day.



Use Ventilation

Switch on fans when you cook or shower.

Keep on for 5 minutes after use.



Keep Rooms Warm & Cosy


Heat rooms to a consistent warmth of at least 18 °C.

Still have mould problems? Tell your landlord.



Air Dry Clothes

Dry clothes by an open window or use a trusted dehumidifier.



Keep Doors Shut

Close the bathroom door when showering.

Wipe excess water off tiles & glass after use.



Give Walls Space

Move big furniture at least 5 cm away from cold walls.

Precautions:



Test a small area first.

Coloured grout can lighten.



Do not use on fabric or plants.



Do not pour into drains.

Keep leftover liquid in the original bottle with the cap on.



When empty, take it to your local recycling centre.
